#### What should a camper bring?

Parents: Please initial your camper's belongings with a permanent marker! Each camper should bring:

- A BIBLE!
- Bedding pillow, sleeping bag or twin size bed sheets and blanket, personal fan, extension cord for fan
- Clothing shorts, shirts, swimwear, jeans and light jacket (for cool nights), shoes suitable for camp (please see "Camp Rule #2: Dress Code" below and leave your good clothes and shoes at home)
- Personal toiletries including toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, soap, shampoo, towels, washcloths
- Miscellaneous pen, notebook
- Money for missions, canteen, or a camp T-shirt (please see the info on canteen cards)

#### What are the rules?

- 1. The Deans have authority in their camp session.
- 2. Dress Code: No halter-tops, no bare midriffs, no strapless tops, no short shorts. Swimwear must be modest with no plunging necklines. The Dean has the final say on matters of dress.
- 3. No one will be permitted to leave camp without the Dean's permission.
- 4. The use or possession of tobacco, alcohol, or drugs is not allowed. This includes vaping devices and marijuana. All medications are to be turned in at registration.
- 5. Camper vehicles must remain parked during camp and keys given to the Dean.
- 6. Campers are NOT to bring iPods, cell phones, books, gaming systems, etc.
- 7. During the week of camp, activities at home should come second.
- 8. Any Questions? Refer to rule #1!

#### Can I visit my camper?

- We ask all visitors to observe the camp rules and report to a Dean upon arrival. Contacting a dean before coming is helpful as well.
- Visitors are welcome for the evening session. They may come for dinner at 5 pm and stay until after worship. Dinner is \$10 per person.
- Visitors are requested to leave as soon as Evening Worship concludes.
- Any adult planning to spend the night will be asked to pass a background check.

### How do I find the camp?

SCCA is located northeast of Clarence, MO, and just west of Shiloh Christian Children's Ranch. Our address: 4770 Camp Rd., Clarence, MO 63437



If you're coming from the East (follow the blue arrow): Exit off of HWY 36 at Clarence on to HWY 151 North. Follow 151 for 2 miles. Turn right on HWY MM and continue Eastward for approximately 3 miles. The camp will be located on your right.

If you're coming from the West (follow the red arrow): Exit off of HWY 36 at Clarence. Take a left on Old US 36. Take a left at the stop sign (this is HWY 151). Continue North on HWY 151 for 2 miles to HWY MM. Turn right on HWY MM and continue Eastward for approximately 3 miles. The camp will be located on your right, next door to Shiloh- Christian Children's Ranch.

The **ENTIRE BALANCE** of the tuition must be paid before your camper can attend camp.

Most churches have different methods of registering their campers. Please check with your church leadership if you have any questions regarding the registration process.

Refund Policy: A camper is eligible for a tuition refund minus \$25 if registration is rescinded before seven days of their camp's opening day. No refunds will be given within seven days of their camp's opening day.

A camper's tuition can also be transferred to another camper for that same session of camp from the same church before seven days of their camp's opening day.

#### What is Included with Tuition?

The cost of tuition covers essentials like meals and a safe place to stay. Other services, like our on-site pool, lifeguard, cook and other essentials are included.

T-shirts and Canteen are NOT included in tuition. If you sign up your camper before the Early-Bird Deadline (May 15th, 2023), your child will receive a t-shirt at camp for free. If they sign up after this date, they will need to purchase one for \$15. Canteen Cards can be purchased at check-in, and usually range about \$3-4 dollars per day at camp. Any leftover money from the Canteen Cards will be donated to each week's missionary.

#### Check-in:

All campers must check in upon their arrival at camp with the Camp Registrar located in the upstairs of the Retreat Center.

## CHILDREN WILL NOT BE ABLE TO ATTEND CAMP IF THEIR TUITION IS NOT PAID IN FULL.

Please be respectful of our camp staff and do not arrive earlier than the registration time for your camp session.

At check-in, each Camper will purchase a "Canteen Card." The Camper can load money onto the card to be spent at canteen. Remaining balances can be refunded or donated to the missionary. Campers frequently misplace cash, and this gives everyone peace of mind about the Camper's money. If you have further questions don't hesitate to ask at check-in.

#### Check-out:

All campers will need to be picked up within one hour of the closing of their camp. No one will be dismissed before the closing time of the camp without prior approval from the Dean.

To ensure the safety of our campers, we will be checking out all campers on the last day of camp. When you check in your camper on the opening day of camp, you will be asked who has permission to pick up your camper at the end of the week of camp. We will then be able to ensure your camper is leaving with the correct party. Thank you for assisting us with this procedure to protect our campers.
